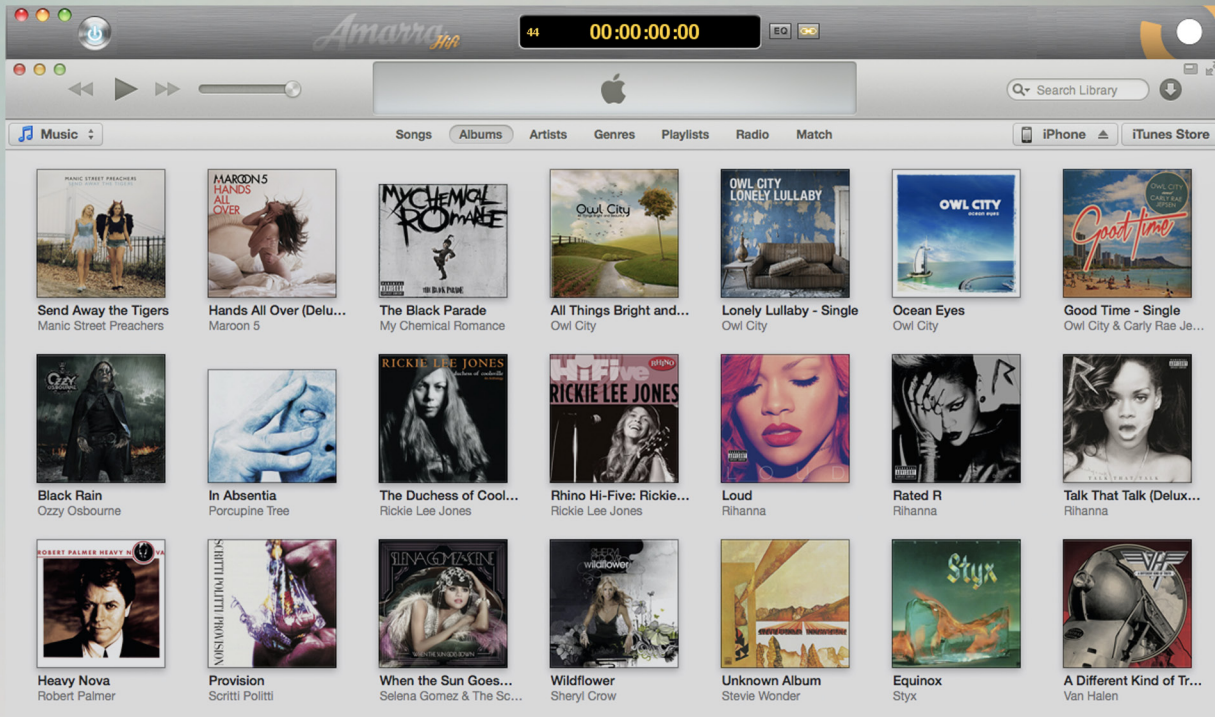

# Amarra Hifi v2.6 Read Me (Build 4500)

Thank you for downloading the new release of version 2.6 of Amarra Hifi. Please read this document before installing and running Amarra Hifi 2.6, it contains important information about the installation and operation of your application.

## 1.0 Application Requirements

Amarra Hifi requires the following:

Computer:

- Any Intel-based Mac - PPC / G5 is not supported.
- RAM: 4 GB minimum, 6 GB or more preferred
- Output Device/DAC: Core Audio Interface (Built-in, Optical, USB, and FireWire)

Supported Audio Hardware DACs (Digital/Analog Converter):

- Most USB and FireWire interfaces work well and are recommended for best performance.
- The built-in Audio (optical/digital/toslink) will work with Amarra, but will have limited sample rate support up to 96kHz. Please note some pre-mid-2010 Macs do not support 88.2kHz sample rates.

Software:

- Mac OS X 10.6.8 and above
- Amarra
- iTunes 10.0 and above

**NOTE:** A network connection is required to authorize your software.

## 2.0 Evaluation Mode

Evaluating an Amarra product has never been easier. Just launch your product and select the Evaluate button to access the full-feature, 15-day evaluation version (Figure 1 below). No Email address is required.

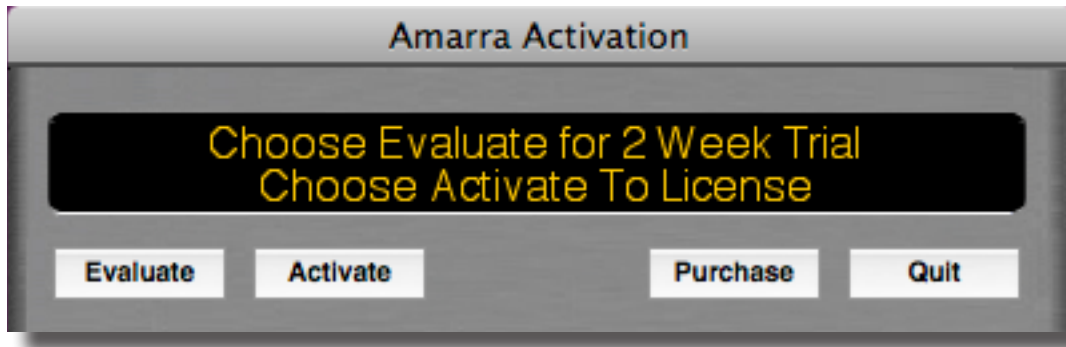

## 6.0 Software Change Information

Changes since 2.5.1 (build 4488) —

- Fixes for Metadata and Artwork for FLAC files in Playlists and iTunes
- Bug and performance fixes

Changes since 2.5 (build 4460) —

- Removed Set Amarra for Playback and Set iTunes for Playback
- Fixed Amarra Hifi On/Off button to only show Blue/Yellow
- Fixes for Hifi counter on 88.2k files with environments that don't support 88.2k files
- Add Alert to Disable Shuffle mode in iTunes when enabling PreloadTracks in Amarra
- Added Purge OS/X Inactive Memory
- Added check for Inactive memory and warn on launch (if inactive > free)
- Added Tracks Menu to Amarra Hifi UI

## 7.0 Known Issues

Please refer to your documentation or visit our FAQ at [www.sonicstudio.com/amarra/amarrafaq.html](http://www.sonicstudio.com/amarra/amarrafaq.html) for a complete list of known issues and workarounds.

- Amarra can not play "psuedo"-files in iTunes created by other players ( i.e. Pure Music flac alias files).
- Some MP3 files may display an incorrect rate in a Playlist.
- Some network drives may not work well with Amarra. The DroboShare is one example.
- Files with ":" or quotes "" may not play.
- Apple Lossless
  - Earlier versions of Apple Lossless files may not play
  - Apple Lossless created in Max and xld may not play correctlyNote: Converting to AIFF and back to ALAC using iTunes is a work around.
- Very large iTunes libraries (> 30,000 tracks) may have problems with skipping tracks.
- There is a small issue in Amarra that may require the application be rebooted when left running for few days.
