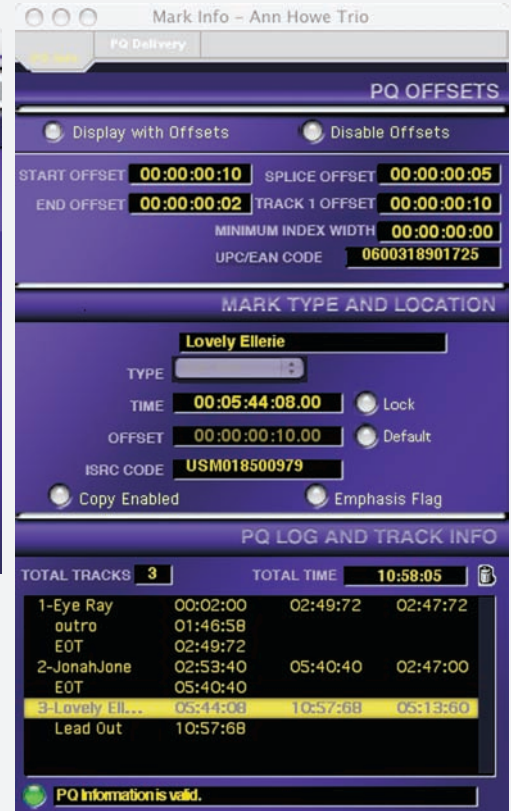
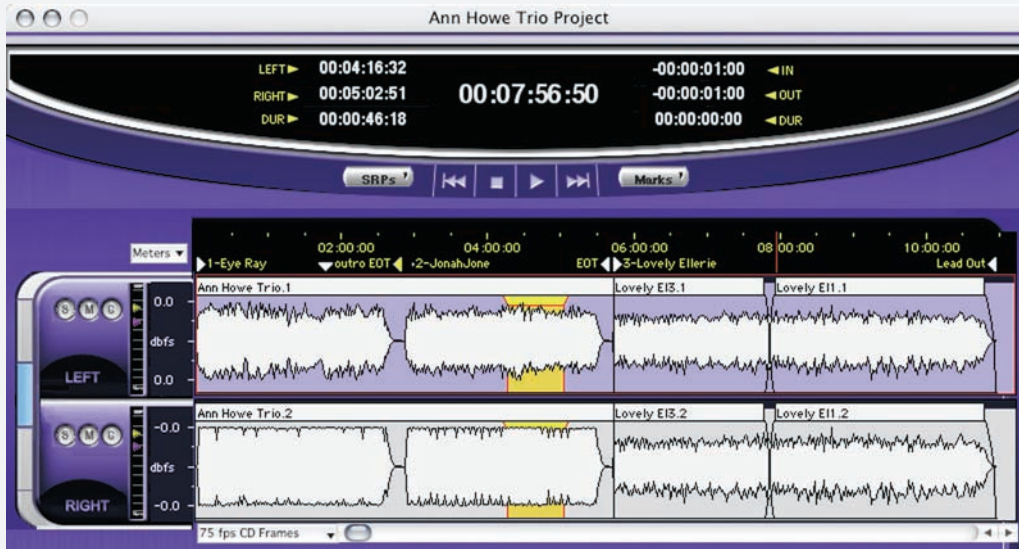

A simple interface makes quick work of repurposing in-house or your client's material, providing an inexpensive way to insure error-free replication of new projects while extending the life cycle of pre-existing product.

Calling All Vendors

DDP modification begins by opening a finished audio file or DDP "image," a set of files containing both audio data and metadata that completely describes a replicated disc. More importantly, DDP files wrap that information in iron clad protection against errors. SonicStudio•DDP can open AIFF, WAV, SD2, BWF and DDP images from all vendors, regardless of platform.

A Detailed View

Once a file or image is selected, SonicStudio•DDP opens the file and automatically creates waveform metadata in the background. With the audio immediately available for playback, you can begin the process of editing, assembling, marking or remarking the material. Using Sonic Studio's famously detailed waveform display, you can zoom in to inspect a fade to digital black or jump out instantly to see the entire program, all with a single keystroke.

Quiet, Ears At Work

Mastering requires critical listening and SonicStudio•DDP lets you do what you do best. Written specifically for Mac OS X, SonicStudio•DDP uses our

SSE™ real time audio engine with Core Audio's native playback mechanism. This means you're free to choose the appropriate quality of digital to analog conversion, from the computer's native converters to ultrahigh quality reference models favored by mastering engineers. This portability also frees you to work whenever and wherever your expertise is needed.

Mark It Up

SonicStudio•DDP enlists the same markup technology found in our bellwether SonicStudio HD product preferred by mastering engineers worldwide. So, complete PQ support is assured, allowing special handling of segues along with emphasis, UPC/EAN and ISRC codes. To further speed your work, entry of PQ information is validated on the fly and inconsistencies visually trigger a warning indicator.

Quick & Easy Finish

To complete the mastering process, newly edited and assembled programs can be printed to disk for electronic delivery or burned to optical media, complete with gain changes. For replication output, one click is all it takes to write out a version 2.0-compliant image, universally sanctioned by pressing plants as the preferred method of disc replication. Unlike audio CDs, DDP images on your choice of media, whether DVD-R, CD-R or via a network, are protected against errors that can crop up when recordable audio discs are used as masters.
