SACD.1 accepts stereo and 5- or 6-channel soundfiles for SACD authoring. We have not yet done testing with 3 or 4 channel soundfiles.

Here are some known issues. They are on our list of things to change:

- 1) It is important that you do not attempt to do editing of the soundfiles in SACD.1. We have disabled much of the editing functions, but there is still more to go.
- 2) When you import a .mts text file, it is necessary to manually enter one text field to force the program to copy the data into the file. An easy one is to type in the catalog number, and hit Enter.
- 3) If you are using a 5-channel soundfile, you have to select the 6th track of the Multichannel EDL and delete it (by going to EDL > Delete Track) after importing the soundfile.
- 4) If, for any reason, the program is aborted or errors out, you will need to manually delete any partially encoded DST file or disc image file.
