118th AES Activities for Sonic Studio

Company Set to Launch, Demo & Preview New Professional Solutions

Newbury Park, CA — May 11, 2005 — The Audio Engineering Society will be holding their 118th Convention in Barcelona, Spain, at the end of May. Also being demonstrated will be more additions to NoNOISE V2, including an updated high definition, multichannel incarnation of Sonic Studio's ground breaking Broadband DeNoiser first shown during the 117th AES Convention in San Francisco.

Future tech at the Sonic Studio booth will illustrate the ongoing commitment to following the development roadmap set out by company executives. New, multichannel production hardware and software will share the stage along with experimental software modules for restoration and workflow improvement.
